

KSC and Cape Canaveral AF Base boundaries:

- -to the West is the Indian River
- -to the North is the Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge
- -to the South is Port Canaveral
- -to the East is the Atlantic Ocean

Playalinda Beach –

- -From the parking area it is 3.8 miles to LC 39A, if you are willing to walk a bit, the fence line is only 2.8 miles from LC 39A.
- -Open 6 am 6 pm.
- -Entry cost is \$20 per vehicle.
- -Can be closed by NASA for launches.
- -Amenities chemical toilets and some picnic tables; no pavilions.

Parrish Park-

- -11.5 miles to LC 39A (open during launch days)
- -Open dawn until dusk
- -11 picnic areas and shelters, 100 foot fishing dock, grills, pavilions and restrooms

Sand Point Park-

- -Parking for viewing from the Max Brewer Bridge (11.79 miles to LC 39A)
- -12.2 miles to LC 39A (open during launch days)
- -Open dawn until dusk
- -Astronaut Memorial is located near south entrance to park
- -11 small to mid-sized pavilions, grills, picnic tables, restrooms
- -1 large pavilion with kitchen (up to 250 people) available 321-264-5105

Kennedy Point Park-

- -12.3 miles to LC 39A
- -pavilions, grills, restrooms
- -large parking area
- -321-264-5037

Could also consider – Rotary Riverfront Park, Marina Park, Space View Park, Manzo Park –all are similar distances (12-13 miles from LC 39A).
