KSC and Cape Canaveral AF Base boundaries:

- to the West is the Indian River
- to the North is the Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge
- to the South is Port Canaveral
- to the East is the Atlantic Ocean

Playalinda Beach –

- From the parking area it is 3.8 miles to LC 39A, if you are willing to walk a bit, the fence line is only 2.8 miles from LC 39A.
- Open 6 am – 6 pm.
- Entry cost is \$20 per vehicle.
- Can be closed by NASA for launches.
- Amenities – chemical toilets and some picnic tables; no pavilions.

Parrish Park-

- 11.5 miles to LC 39A (open during launch days)
- Open dawn until dusk
- 11 picnic areas and shelters, 100 foot fishing dock, grills, pavilions and restrooms

Sand Point Park-

- Parking for viewing from the Max Brewer Bridge (11.79 miles to LC 39A)**
- 12.2 miles to LC 39A (open during launch days)
- Open dawn until dusk
- Astronaut Memorial is located near south entrance to park
- 11 small to mid-sized pavilions, grills, picnic tables, restrooms
- 1 large pavilion with kitchen (up to 250 people) available – 321-264-5105

Kennedy Point Park-

- 12.3 miles to LC 39A
- pavilions, grills, restrooms
- large parking area
- 321-264-5037

Could also consider – Rotary Riverfront Park, Marina Park, Space View Park, Manzo Park –all are similar distances (12-13 miles from LC 39A).
